## Introducing Japan's "Quality Infrastructure" to the African Embassies in Tokyo in Cooperation with Japan-Africa Infrastructure Development Association

1st City Tour in FY2017

The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism in cooperation with the Japan-Africa Infrastructure Development Association (JAIDA)\* held the "City Tour" for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time for the Ambassadors and officials of African embassies in Tokyo, to introduce Japan's "Quality Infrastructure" and establish the relationships with African countries. Japan's traffic signaling system and flood-control measures in urban area were introduced to 24 Ambassadors and officials from 15 countries.
